CAMP VUGHT NATIONAL MEMORIAL

In 1943 Konzentrationslager Herzogenbusch was built in Vught - the only SS concentration camp outside Nazi Germany. The memorial centre tells of Camp Vught's beginnings and the national-socialist system. In just 18 months, more than 32,000 people were kept prisoner, mostly because they were Jewish or because they worked for the resistance.



MACZEK MEMORIAL BREDA

On the 29th of October 1944. Breda was liberated in a man-to-man fight by a Polish division commanded by General Maczek. As from 2019 the Story of the Poles will be told in the General Maczek Memorial and museum. Next to the Memorial you'll find the Polish Military Field of Honor.



WAR MUSEUM **OVERLOON**

The museum is located in the middle of the battlefield of the Overloon tank battle of 1944. It houses a large, comprehensive exhibition about the Netherlands during WW2 with more than 150 military vehicles. This makes Overloon the largest war museum in the Netherlands.



CANADIAN WAR CEMETERY & BRITISH WAR CEMETERY

The Battle of the Scheldt was one of the biggest military operations carried out during WW2 by Canadian, British and Polish troops and operated under Canadian command. The Canadian, British and Polish soldiers received orders to capture the Western Scheldt. Most of the fallen in both cemeteries lost their lives during this operation.



WINGS OF LIBERATION MUSEUM

Operation Market Garden was one of the most important military events in the history of the Netherlands. Follow in the footsteps of the 101st Airborne Division heroes and relive the story that led to the liberation of the southern Netherlands at the Wings of Liberation Museum.



CITY OF EINDHOVEN (18 SEPTEMBER FOUNDATION)

Since 1945, Eindhoven has organised a number of historical, cultural and sporting events for its liberation every year. The main events take place on the 18th of september, the day Eindhoven was liberated from the German occupiers by the American 101st Airborne Division and the Second British army.

#1 Operation Market Garden: Hell's Highway - One day tour by coach

The largest airborne operation the world had ever seen, an audacious plan, and desperate fighting to get to Arnhem. Famously known for the battle at Arnhem, many of the reasons why British 30 Corps failed to get to Arnhem in time lie in the fighting in Brabant. This tour explores the advance of British 30 Corps and the battles fought by US 101st Airborne Division to keep 'Hell's Highway' open.

#2 US 7th Armored Division in Brabant - One day tour by coach

After Operation Market Garden, German presence in a salient on the west bank of the river Maas posed a threat to Allied plans to advance east into Germany. Attempting to clear the salient, the initial assault was made by US 'Lucky 7th' Armored Division. For almost six days the division struggled to break through the German lines in heavy autumn rains. Later, the division took up defensive positions in the Peel marshes, where they were hit by a severe German counterattack. This tour takes you to the places where the American and Germans clashed in this fierce battle.

#3 Occupation and liberation of Eindhoven - Three hours city walking tour Get a taste of what it was like to live in a Dutch town during World War Two. While walking through the city, you will visit several places related to either the occupation or liberation. You will hear the stories of what the people back then experienced, as well as the stories of soldiers participating in the liberation of the city. Backed up with photographs, maps and visible traces of that period, you will gain an exclusive insight in what live was like in the 1940-1945 era.

#4 US 104th Infantry Division in Brabant - One day tour by coach Clearing the western part of Brabant tied up many British and Canadian divisions. Needing extra manpower, the newly arrived US 104th 'Timberwolves' Infantry Division was inserted into the line. The division fought as the first and only US division alongside British and Polish divisions as part of a British army corps in the 1st Canadian Army, During October and November 1944 this division quickly gained fame, liberating several towns and villages in this part of The Netherlands.

#5 Biesbosch Line Crossers - Three hours boat tour

The Biesbosch area is one of the largest freshwater tidal wetlands in Northwest Europe. During World War Two this large maze of rivers, creeks and islands was used from autumn 1944 till the end of the war. The area was used for clandestine traffic of men and information between the liberated and still occupied part of the Netherlands. This tour takes you on a unique boat trip through the Biesbosch. During the tour you will hear the stories of the dangerous cat and mouse game played between Germans and Dutch resistance workers in cooperation with British intelligence units, and see some traces of the war.
